**SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE WEATHER / FLOOD FORECAST:**

**I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:**

River Indus at Kalabagh & Chashma and River Chenab at Khanki are in Low Flood Level.

**II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. Yesterday's well marked Monsoon low over Eastern parts of Jharkhand moved North-Westwards and today lies over Northwest Jharkhand.
- b. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over North of Afghanistan today lies over North of the country.
- c. Weak Seasonal low lies over North Balochistan.
- d. Light to Moderate moist current from Bay of Bengal is penetrating upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.

**III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:**

Scattered thunderstorm/rain of Moderate Intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Peshawar, Kohat, Banu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala & Sargodha Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over Lahore, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Multan, DG Khan & Bahawalpur Divisions.

**IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR 48 Hours:**

No significant change.
